1. Book your Assessments for Success

- Assessments for Success are required for first semester Mohawk Students. They are designed to assess your skills and help you succeed.
- **To book your Assessments for Success appointment online:** Login to your MoCoMotion Account mocomotion.mohawkcollege.ca. Click on "Book your Assessments for Success" (on the Main Menu) or contact the Assessment Centre at 905.575.2042. For sample questions and for more information visit mohawkcollege.ca/StudentServices/Assessments. Contact Accessible Learning Services at 905.575.2211 if testing accommodations are required due to a disability.
- **ESL (English as a Second Language)** students are advised to take the ESL version of the Assessments for Success. Please call 905.575.1212 ext. 3569 to arrange a time for this assessment.

2. Organize your Financial Assistance

- Apply for Ontario Student Assistance Program (OSAP) loans at <http://osap.gov.on.ca> early so funds are available when you start classes in the Fall.
- Complete a profile at mohawkcollege.ca/financialprofile to be considered for a tuition bursary, awards, shuttle bus assistance and the Campus Student Employment program. Funding supports have deadline dates so apply early. For fall, the application deadline date is July 31, 2012.

3. Pay your Fees – Due Tuesday, July 3rd

- Secure your place in your program and avoid late fees by paying on time! See your fee statement for details on how to make payment. International Students see your offer letter for your payment details.

4. Get Ready for College!

- **Attend Start Smart to Prepare for College Success, Fennell Campus: Thursday, June 28th – 10:00 am to 3:00 pm or Tuesday, August 28th – 10:00 am to 3:00 pm:** Lunch and concurrent sessions such as: introduction to the college information portal MoCoMotion, Job Centre, Learning Support Centre, Financial Assistance, Tips for Success, Student Leadership, and much more...
- **Get your Student Card:** Get your card at The Square – Student Services, Fennell Campus or at your campus Student Engagement Office
- **Apply for Exemptions** online through Self Service on the Welcome Tab on MoCoMotion
- **Apply for Prior Learning Assessment and Recognition, if applicable:** plar@mohawkcollege.ca
- **Contact Accessible Learning Services** – if needed at accessiblelearningservices@mohawkcollege.ca or call 905.575.2211
- **Plan your Transportation**
 - Apply for your parking pass online aims.mohawkcollege.ca or at IAHS at parking.mcmaster.ca.
 - Contact Student Engagement for shuttle bus information studentengagement.mohawkcollege.ca
 - Full-time post secondary students at Fennell, IAHS, and STARRT can ride the HSR with their validated student card.

5. Choose Courses and Timetable Online to Complete Registration!

- **Thursday, July 12th – When to Register Online:** Go to the Welcome Tab on MoCoMotion and click on "Fall 2012 – When to Register Online" to see when registration for your program will be available.
- **Thursday, July 26th to Friday, August 24th – Registration period:** Go to the Welcome Tab on MoCoMotion and click on "Fall 2012 – Choose or Change your Timetable". Choose early to get your preferred timetable.
- **Thursday, August 30th – Add period begins:** Students may begin to register in missed course(s) from previous semesters or for course(s) for which they received special authorization.
- **No Computer? We would be happy to assist.** Computers are available at the Student Services' offices at all campuses.

6. Attend your Orientation

- Welcome Guide available on MoCoMotion, highlighting orientation activities – **August 20th.**
- **Tuesday, September 4th:** Orientation for all New Students. Meet your faculty and classmates, information and activities.

7. Attend Mohawk!

- **CLASSES START WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 5TH (FOR MOST PROGRAMS)**
- Check your timetable just before classes start as changes to student timetables are sometimes necessary. Follow your online timetable for times and locations.
