

## **Educational Assistant Apprenticeship to Diploma Requirements**

A program exists that facilitates individuals who are working as Educational Assistants (EA's) and who have met all of the requirements for the Educational Assistant Apprenticeship Certificate of Completion, to complete the courses required to be awarded an Educational Assistant Ontario College Diploma. Mohawk College is approved as an MTCU TDA for EA apprenticeship and has approval to award an EA Ontario College Diploma. Mohawk has also worked to develop, through Ontario Learn, a bridging program to support access to the Ontario College Diploma for EA Apprenticeship grads actively working across Ontario. The bridging program will use Mohawk College courses delivered through Ontario Learn. To meet the Educational Program Learning Outcomes, there are 13 courses that need to be completed, in addition to the EA Apprenticeship Certificate of Completion. Once a student has completed the 13 courses, Mohawk College will award the student with a Mohawk College, Ontario College Diploma in the field of Educational Assistant.
