





STUDENT AWARDS PROGRAM

Students are at the heart of all we do and Mohawk College wants to ensure that all students have the financial means to complete their academic journey. To facilitate this success, the Foundation works with community partners to offer student awards in the form of scholarships and bursaries.

TYPES OF AWARDS

SCHOLARSHIPS:

Recognize students based on academic merit. Students can apply for these awards or can be determined by college faculty.

BURSARIES:

Available to students with proven financial need. Students apply for these awards.

SUPPORT FUNDS:

Disbursed at the discretion of the program based on predetermined criteria.

ESTABLISHING AN AWARD

Student awards can be annually funded or created in the form of an endowment where the capital, (the gift), is retained and only the interest is used to fund your award each year. By selecting one of these options, you will help to transform the life of a student here at Mohawk College.

ANNUAL AWARDS:

A minimum annual gift of \$500 with a preferred commitment of five years.

ENDOWED AWARDS:

Gifts to the endowment fund are invested by Mohawk College and the annual interest funds a scholarship or bursary each year. A minimum gift of \$25,000 provides \$625 each year to assist a student.

AWARD DISTRIBUTION

Awards are distributed through two channels:

GENERAL

Awards are promoted throughout the academic year (September 1 – August 31) and students may apply to them through Financial Assistance.

FACULTY

Students are nominated by their faculty in December and February each year.

OUTLINING YOUR AWARD CRITERIA

Consider selecting criteria in following areas:

- 1. School
- 2. Program
- 3. Year of Study



NAMING YOUR AWARD

Once you have decided how you would like to fund your award, you will be invited to name your award. We would be delighted to honour and recognize your generosity in this fashion.

AWARD RECIPIENT INFORMATION

After the recipient has been selected, they will be notified by the Financial Assistance office. During this time, their information will be processed and students will provide a thank you letter. The Foundation will then notify you of the recipient and will share their thank you letter. The donor is welcome to continue to communicate with the recipient.
