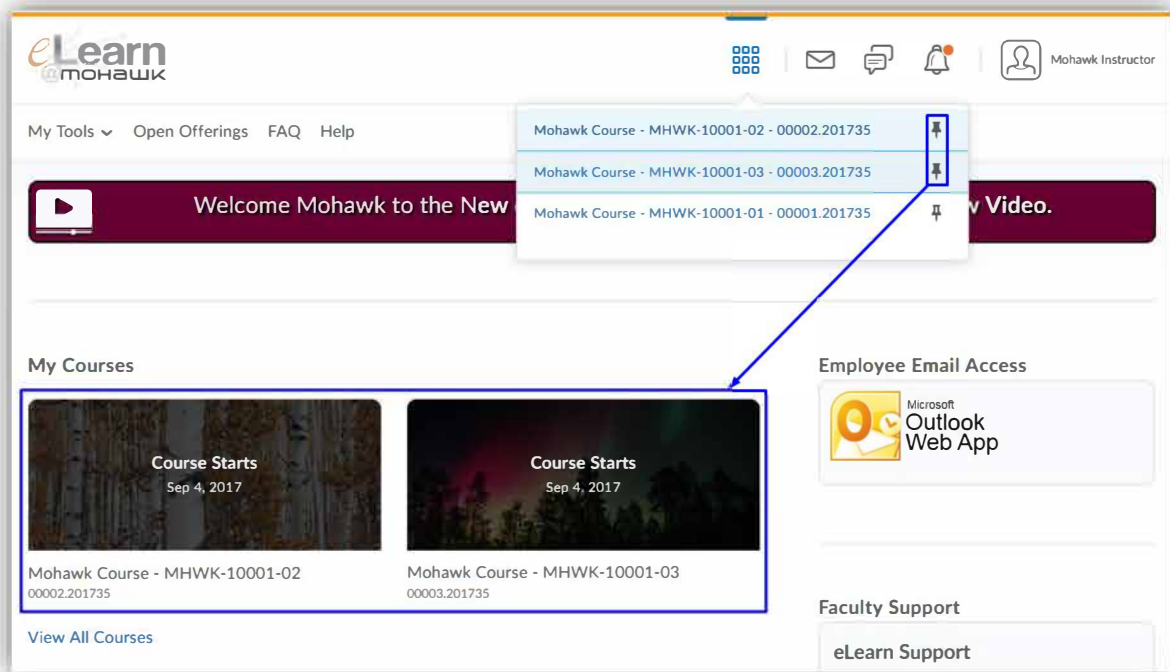



Pinning Your Semester's Courses for Quick Access

One of the changes to come with the **Daylight Experience** in eLearn is the way in which the **My Courses Widget** now displays your courses. If you are a newer instructor, you are likely used to the semester-based view of this widget. If you are an instructor with more than 100 total course enrolments, you are likely used to seeing a view based on the last 20 courses you accessed. With the Daylight Experience the My Courses Widget will now only display the courses you have pinned by means of the **"Select a course..."** dropdown menu.



The system will try and auto-pin your current and upcoming semester's courses so long as you have less than 100 total course enrollments. If you do have more than 100 total course enrollments, you will want to pin your current semester's courses manually to ensure quick access to them. You can do so by accessing the  **"Select a course..."** drop down menu on the **Minibar** at the top of eLearn and searching for your current semester's courses by their **term code**. The term code is different depending on whether or not you have crosslisted your courses or not (see above).
