Recognized Student Groups

Mohawk College Student Life

Some student groups that fall outside of activity and academic based clubs may qualify as a registered student group. For example religious, political or social.

Mohawk College does not formally sanction these groups, and does not provide funding. Mohawk College will assist with advertising and promoting these groups and event planning. All fundraising activities must be approved through Student Life prior to taking place.

It is the discretion of Mohawk College whether or not to deem a group of registered student groups. Groups that host activities contrary to the Student Behavior Policy may be disbanded and students held accountable under the recognized student group manual as well as the policy.

These registered student groups must:

- have a faculty advisor
- provide contact information to Student Life
- provide an outline of activities and events to Student Life

Ontario Human Rights Code

Age
Ancestry, colour, race
Citizenship (New comers, Immigrants)
Ethnic origin
Place of origin
Creed
Disability
Family status
Marital status (including single status)
Gender identity, gender expression
Receipt of public assistance
Record of offences (this one would present some challenges for us, but luckily it has never come up)
Sex (including pregnancy and breastfeeding)
Sexual orientation
