

MRI Corporate Training Program

Program Foundations

Mohawk College's MRI Corporate training program was developed in partnership with Hamilton Health Sciences (HHS) in an effort to overcome the backlog in MRI wait times in our region. The accelerated program is delivered as a full-time training opportunity for current employees who are actively registered CMRITO radiographers/sonographers, nuclear medicine MRT, cardiac sonographers or radiation therapists, increasing the staffing compliment of technologists in as little as 28 weeks.

Program Structure



14 WEEKS OF VIRTUAL LEARNING

Learners will participate in 14 weeks of online didactic education through Mohawk College.



14 WEEK CLINICAL PRACTICUM

Learners will complete a 14-week clinical practicum facilitated by the sponsoring employer at the learner's home hospital location under the supervision of staff educators.

Recognition for the completion of training will come in the form of a Mohawk College certificate upon program completion and all learners will be eligible to sit for the board exam. The CAMRT exam fee is not included in the program tuition.

General Outcomes of the MRI Corporate Training Program

At the end of the course, graduates will have developed the skills and ability to:

- Demonstrate professional competence by meeting all requirements set forth in the MRI Corporate Training learning outcomes, and be able to demonstrate competence in their specific area of practice within the probationary period
- Provide care which recognizes and respects the dignity, culture and individuality of patients and clients
- Critically evaluate the role of the MRI technologist within the multi-disciplinary healthcare team
- Act in an ethical and accountable manner
- Communicate effectively in all aspects of the profession
- Work as an effective member of the team
