STEP 1 **Choose Your Program**

Mohawk offers a wide range of more than 100 programs that open career opportunities for international students.

Pay special attention to the deadlines for competitive programs (indicated with  beside the program name)—those programs have more qualified applicants than there are spaces. You are encouraged to apply for these high-demand programs as early as possible to be considered for the limited number of spaces available.



STEP 2 **Apply via Ontario College Application Service (OCAS)**

The OCAS International Application Service (IAS) is an online application process that will only take a few minutes. If you need to take a break, your progress will be saved and you will be able to continue right where you left off when you return. Apply online now at mohawkcollege.ca/OCAS-International.



STEP 3 **Confirming Your Offer of Admission**

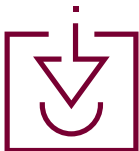
When you receive an Offer of Admission from Mohawk, you must then confirm you accept the offer, and pay fees, before the due date on your letter. This is done online through the OCAS International Applicant portal. Once you pay the required fees and accept your offer of admission you will receive a letter of acceptance that you can use for immigration purposes.



STEP 4 **Receive Your Letter of Acceptance**

If your application is successful you will receive a letter of acceptance from Mohawk College. This letter of acceptance is required for you to apply for your study permit and is the official document for immigration purposes.

Remember to review the document and ensure you fill out all the required steps.



STEP 5 **Apply for Your Study Permit**

With your letter of acceptance, you should immediately apply for your study permit.

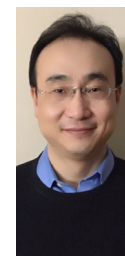

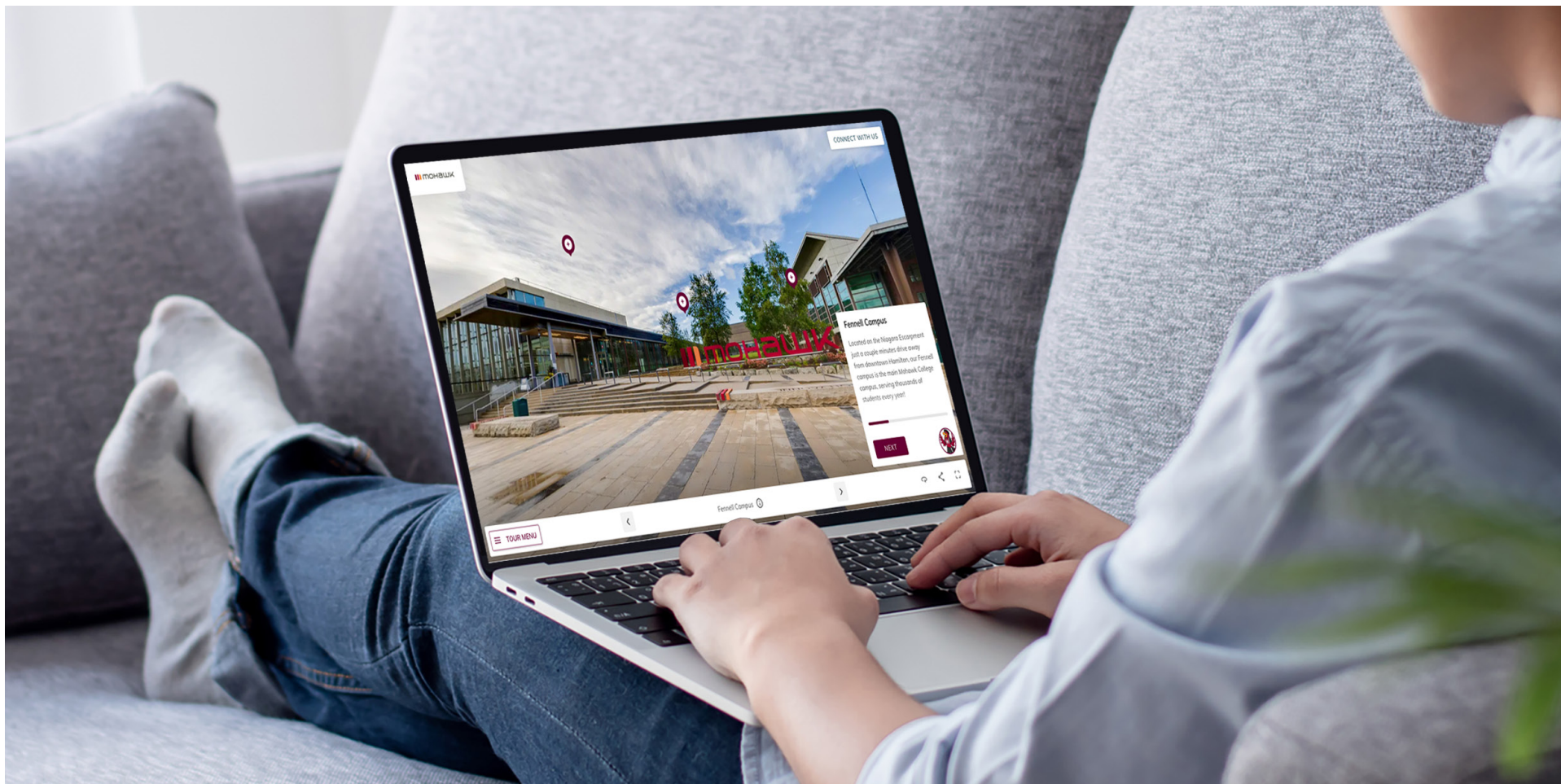

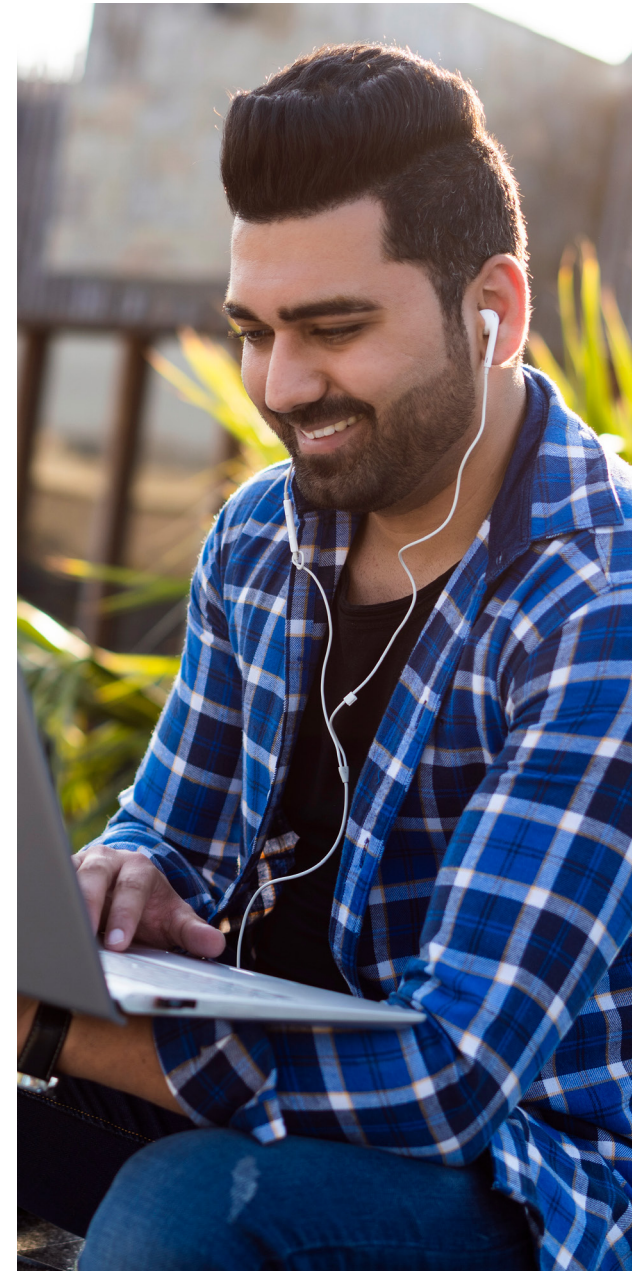

Analytics for Business Decision Making

mohawkcollege.ca/386

This program prepares you to become a skilled data professional and an essential contributor to business decision-making processes. Learn to analyze and interpret digital information and use business intelligence and data analytics software with a focus on data identification, consolidation, communication, reporting, manipulation and trending. Graduates may pursue obtaining the Certified Analytics Professional designation.

Career opportunities

Graduates may work in positions such as data analyst, business analyst, data scientist and business intelligence analyst. Fields of employment include technology sector, marketing, finance, sports and entertainment, insurance and health care.

Autism and Behavioural Science

mohawkcollege.ca/164

You will learn about the science of Applied Behaviour Analysis and how to design and apply evidence-based treatments to teach socially significant skills to individuals with Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD), acquired brain injuries, mental health disorders,

and developmental disabilities. Students learn how to collect and analyze data to inform programming decisions, how to use an ethical decision making framework to guide professional practice, and have the opportunity to complete two field placements to apply their classroom knowledge. This program has been verified by the Association for Behavior Analysis International (ABAI) and meets the coursework requirements for eligibility to take the Board Certified Assistant Behavior Analyst® (BCaBA) examination (additional requirements must be completed in order to qualify).

Career opportunities

Graduates may work in positions such as instructor therapist, behaviour therapist or Applied Behaviour Analysis (ABA) therapist. Areas of employment include community / private treatment agencies, private family residences, hospital/ clinical settings and school boards.

Bachelor of Technology Partnership: Degree Completion Program

Get a degree that works for you in Civil, Manufacturing, Power and Energy, or Software Engineering Technology. The W Booth School of Engineering Practice and Technology at McMaster University and School of Engineering at Mohawk

College have collaborated to provide a unique pathway for college graduates. Mohawk grads with an advanced technology diploma can earn a Bachelor of Technology (BTech) degree from McMaster University. All courses are offered through classes at McMaster University and are held in the evenings and on Saturdays. Many students choose to study part-time while they continue to work, however, full-time options are also available.

Career opportunities

Graduates of this program are ideal candidates for engineering, project management, and supervisory roles that require a technical background.

Brain Disorders Management

mohawkcollege.ca/470

As the first program in Ontario to focus on brain disorders management, graduates will be well prepared to support clients or work behind the scenes in research or policy development. Through lectures, patient simulations, specialized training and guest speakers, this program engages a variety of learners. Fully online or in-class options are available for coursework, with a field placement (336 hours) occurring in the final semester.

Career opportunities

Graduates work in rehabilitation clinics, athletic centres, hospitals, research institutions, schools and school boards, retirement homes and non-profit organizations.

Business Analysis

mohawkcollege.ca/334

Learn a variety of business analysis techniques and skills to support new or improved innovative business processes. Coursework includes enterprise analysis and planning, quality assurance methodologies, programming fundamentals, and database design and management. Work in computer labs, using current software to test and apply course concepts. A field placement in the business analysis sector allows you to further enhance your educational experience by applying learning to real world problems.

Career opportunities

Graduates may work as an analyst specializing in business, business process, program quality, data, operations, or business systems. Other roles include change management specialist and project manager, working in areas such as information technology, financial and insurance institutions, health and social services, government and public sector, manufacturing and business professional/consulting.

Concurrent Disorders

mohawkcollege.ca/252

Building on previous academic work, you will learn to assess, treat and work with individuals and families battling addiction and mental health issues who present complex diagnosis and treatment challenges. Coursework includes development of counselling skills, pharmacology for concurrent disorders, supporting families living with concurrent disorders, and relapse prevention and harm reduction. Additionally, you will attain job-ready skills by completing field placements in community organizations.

Career opportunities

Graduates work in positions such as case manager, mental health worker, community worker and addiction worker in a variety of settings including community agencies, day programs, detoxification units, mental health/addiction services and shelters.

Cyber Security Analytics

mohawkcollege.ca/557

You will develop an understanding of cyber security concepts, industry best practices for securing information systems, sensitive data and applications to protect organizations against fraud,

data breaches and other vulnerabilities. Learn how to defend against a cyber attack by participating in real world cyber attack simulations in our brand new, state of the art Cyber Lab. Graduates will be well prepared to develop, implement and evaluate cyber security strategies and solutions for various operating systems, networks, applications and databases.

Career opportunities

Graduates work in areas such as cyber security operations, cyber security threat assessment and policy testing, identity and access management with personal privacy, and auditing and security review. Employment sectors include financial/banking, computing services, medical, education, government, airlines, research institutions, law enforcement and military.

Digital Health

mohawkcollege.ca/594

This program provides extensive hands-on learning opportunities in business, health and technology in our state-of-the-art labs, preparing grads for the rapidly growing field of digital health.

Career opportunities

Graduates may work in positions such as clinical systems analyst, information systems specialist, business processes analyst, health records manager, health systems technician and health informatics specialist.

Early Childhood Education (Intensive)

mohawkcollege.ca/263

This fast-track program has been designed for those who have already earned a related degree or diploma. Learn about the physical, cognitive, social and emotional needs of children. A Living Lab provides a realistic early years environment for hands-on learning. Field placements are built into the curriculum to provide you with the opportunity to integrate classroom learning into practice with groups of children in the community. Coursework includes child development, curriculum, inclusive classrooms, supervision and administration, and health policies and practices.

Career opportunities

Graduates work in a variety of settings which include (but are not limited to) child care centres, family support/resource programs, before and after school programs, early intervention and support services, licensed home child care/agencies and kindergarten classrooms in the elementary school system.

Educational Support (Intensive)

mohawkcollege.ca/997

This fast-track program has been designed for those who have already earned a related degree or diploma. You

will develop skills to work within a school or alternative setting to support students with exceptionalities. Field placements are built into the curriculum to provide you with opportunity to integrate classroom learning into practice with groups of children in the community. Coursework includes technology and adaptive devices in education, transition planning, and physical, multiple and communication exceptionalities.

Career opportunities

Graduates may work in positions such as educational assistant or learning facilitator within school boards, private schools, community facilities offering special education, and college and postsecondary programs.

Global Business Management

mohawkcollege.ca/967

Gain a critical understanding of the important elements of global business, a cultural orientation to Canada, and the language and communication requirements to be effective in a global business setting. Year one is designed to expose you to foundational international and Canadian business practices and help you to strengthen your English communication, math, and statistical skills. Advanced international business practices will be covered in your second year, including Supply Chain, Marketing,

Sales and Negotiation, E-Commerce, Finance, Business Analytics and Project Management. All course work is linked through the completion of an international business capstone project.

Career opportunities

Graduates may work in positions such as business development executive, financial analyst, marketing analyst, transportation manager, customs broker, inventory control coordinator, purchasing agent or procurement clerk.

Human Resources Management

mohawkcollege.ca/113

This graduate program provides training to those seeking employment in the human resources profession or to those currently working in the field who wish to upgrade their training and gain professional accreditation. You will develop strategic skills to effectively manage a diverse workforce in today's ever-changing business environment. Courses provide credits toward the Certified Human Resources Professional (CHRP) designation. You will gain practical experience during a work placement in the final semester.

Career opportunities

Graduates may work in positions such as human resources generalist, recruiter, training and development

specialist, compensation and benefits administrator, labour relations officer or health and safety specialist.

International Business Management

mohawkcollege.ca/116

Gain the necessary product management skills to support global strategies and opportunities within an organization. Graduates are well prepared to develop an international market entry strategy for a service or product, create an international business plan to support the global strategy of a company, and investigate and analyze aspects of international trade for an organization. Participating in interactive business simulations and applying program knowledge through a capstone research project are essential components of the program.

Career opportunities

Graduates may work in positions such as product manager, foreign affairs analyst, international account representative, logistics and distribution specialist, business development executive, transportation manager, customs broker analyst, inventory auditor, purchasing agent or quality assurance manager.

Mental Health and Disability Management

mohawkcollege.ca/475

Investigate the experience of dual diagnoses, including diagnostic criteria, intervention strategies and supports for clients and families. Graduates will be well prepared to support clients with mental illness and disabilities as well as work behind the scenes in research or policy development. Fully online or in-class options are available for coursework, with a field placement (336 hours) occurring in the final semester.

Career opportunities

Graduates work in hospitals, research institutions, schools and school boards, retirement homes and non-profit organizations.

Project Management

mohawkcollege.ca/399

Study in a field that is both highly sought after and relevant to today's business problems and opportunities. Learn from industry-experienced professionals. Considered the cornerstone in many organizations, Project Managers are highly sought after in a wide range of industries. This program addresses emerging trends in project management through courses in Agile project management. Earn micro-badges in Process Mapping and Analytics

with the Mohawk/IBM partnership. Upon completion of the first semester of the program, you'll be eligible to write the Certified Associate in Project Management (CAPM) certification (an entry-level designation offered by the Project Management Institute, PMI).

Career opportunities

Graduates may work in positions such as project manager, scrum manager, product owner, operations analyst, quality assurance analyst, software tester, analytics professional, data analyst, business systems analyst or change management specialist.

Public Relations

mohawkcollege.ca/166

You will be immersed in the public relations industry through classes, labs, hands-on assignments and team-based projects. You will learn how to plan, develop and execute effective public relations strategies and enhance skills in event planning, public speaking and presentation. An industry-based field placement in a public relations or communications setting is integrated into the program curriculum. Graduates are well prepared to formulate PR strategies for all types and sizes of organizations, use social and digital media in PR planning and execution and write professional-level PR materials.

Career opportunities

Graduates may work in positions such as communications/information officer, marketing specialist, social media specialist, content strategy specialist, special events coordinator, speechwriter, publicist or media relations officer.

Supply Chain Management

mohawkcollege.ca/385

Gain an advanced understanding of supply chain within the goods and services sectors. You will learn the financial implications of supply chain decisions on overall business profitability, efficiency and stakeholder satisfaction. Graduates from this program are well prepared to coordinate the efficient handling and movement of goods, services, materials and related information within and between supply chains. The Supply Chain Management program has an active relationship with the Hamilton Oshawa Port Authority.

Career opportunities

Graduates work in positions such as planner supply chain, logistics analyst, supply chain specialist, and procurement specialist. Areas of employment include the aviation industry, manufacturing, public sector, natural resources or third-party logistics.

Graduates may work in positions such as game designer, virtual reality artist, interactive designer, digital media producer or augmented reality programmer.

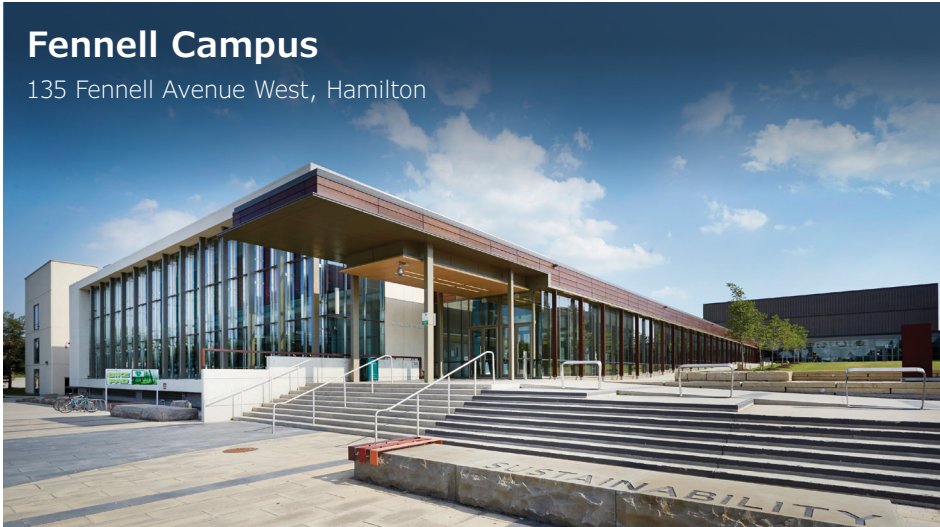
