

To all students and staff:

The end is finally in sight to the longest strike in the history of Ontario colleges.

The government is acting to end the strike by introducing back-to-work legislation. We're hoping that all three parties in the Ontario legislature will put students first and support quick passage of the legislation.

The government has asked the Speaker of the House to reconvene the legislature at 3 p.m. Friday to sit throughout the weekend until the legislation is passed.

We'll keep you updated throughout the weekend. We expect students and faculty to be back at Mohawk within days.

Mohawk has contingency plans in place to continue and complete the fall semester, with classes carrying over into mid-January. Faculty will develop plans for each of their courses once they return to work. We anticipate minimal impact on our winter semester.
